Many school districts in our area, in conjunction with local officials, are joining together in an abundance of caution and will adopt the guidance of the Center for Disease Control (CDC) as a response to the Covid-19 virus outbreak. The Iron County C-4 School District will cancel school starting Monday, March 23<sup>rd</sup> through Friday, April 3<sup>rd</sup>.
